

The rules from Appendix B, Trip Leader's Handbook:

BUS SEATING POLICY

Bus seats are secured on a First-Come/First-Served basis when boarding in the Tri-Cities.

1. A new seating arrangement will again be established on a First Come/First Served basis on the departure day when leaving the place of lodging in the morning.
 - a. Seats may be claimed for yourself and one seatmate only.
 - b. Claims are established by placing an easily identifiable personal item on the seat(s). At no time may a member move a personal article from a seat without permission from the owner or the trip leader.
2. Established seats may be switched only upon mutual agreement of those involved. However, cooperation and consideration of fellow DSC members wishes are encouraged when such a request is made.
3. Seats used during weekend bus transportation do not establish a claim to the seat for the return trip home and any personal articles left on the seats during this time should be removed prior to the boarding that establishes the final seating.
4. Trip leaders are responsible for enforcing this policy judiciously. If a different seating policy would be more equitable due to a trip's unique itinerary or schedule, the trip leader should make this known at the start of the trip.
