Our new website is up and running. We now have both a public area and a members only section. In the public access section we have general club information, an application and our calendar. The members only section includes a .pdf (Adobe Acrobat) copy of the newsletter (starting this August), a membership directory, and a list of board members and their contact information.

To access the members only area from the website, both your default username AND password are your first and last name, no spaces, as it appeared on your 2006 membership application. The password is limited to the first 10 characters of your name. For example, 'John Q. Snowboarder' would be user name = JohnSnowboarder and password = JohnSnowbo - **Yes they are case sensitive.**

When you first log in as a member, you will see there is the opportunity for you to update user name, password, mailing address and phone numbers and email address by clicking on "Edit Your Profile". Once you change your username and/or password, it is very important that we have your up-to-date email address. If you forget it, the system will automatically send it to you at the email address on file when you request it.

We need your input; if you have photos, send them in so that we can add them to the photo gallery. Or if you have suggestions, send them to webmaster@desertskiclub.org! Look forward to hearing from you.

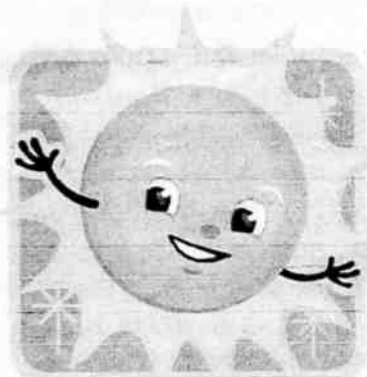

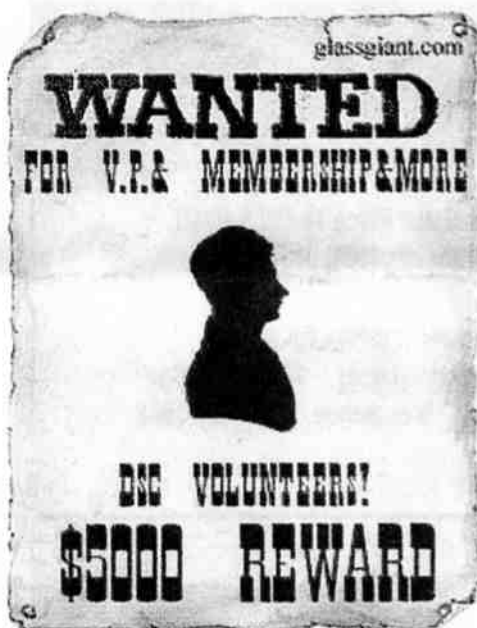
Lynn Leaverton Needs some Lovin'
